



Edging Cushion Mandala Fantasy

Difficulty level: Beginner

Finished size: approx. 45 x 29 cm

Fabrics from the collection "Mandala Fantasy" by MEZfabrics, 100% cotton, approx. 146 cm fabric width

Note: All measurements include a seam allowance of 0.75 cm unless otherwise indicated.

Materials

Fabric A: C130928-03008 MANDALA FANTASY-DREAM-BERRY 35 cm Fabric B: C130930-03007 MANDALA-GRID-BERRY 10 cm

MEZ Duet sewing thread in a matching colour 150 cm cord for the piping, 4 mm Ø (e.g. Parka cord from Prym) approx. 200g polyester deco-wadding from Freudenberg for stuffing

Cutting instructions

For the cushion cover: Fabric A: 2 rectangles 46.5 x 31.5 cm

For the piping: Fabric B: 1 Strip 3.5 cm x WOF

Sewing instructions

- 1. First of all, round the corners of the two cushion cover rectangles, e.g. using a glass. (approx. 6 cm Ø)
- 2. Fold the piping strip B in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, and place the piping cord in the fold, leaving ca 2 cm empty at the beginning. Pin or baste the raw long edges together, then stitch all the way along close to the cord, using the zipper foot on the sewing machine
- 3. Pin or baste the piping around the sides of one rectangle, first of all folding over the seam allowance at the beginning at a 45° angle, then fold again straight across. Stitch all the way around close to the cord, using the zipper foot on the sewing machine. At the end angle the cord off the edge of the rectangle, overlapping the folded beginning edge, and overstitch. Trim away any excess piping.
- 4. Place the second rectangle over the first, right sides together and stitch in place, again using the zipper foot, and leaving an opening of ca 10 cm on the side opposite the beginning/end of the piping for turning and stuffing.
- 5. Turn the cushion cover right sides out, fill with stuffing and close the opening by hand.
